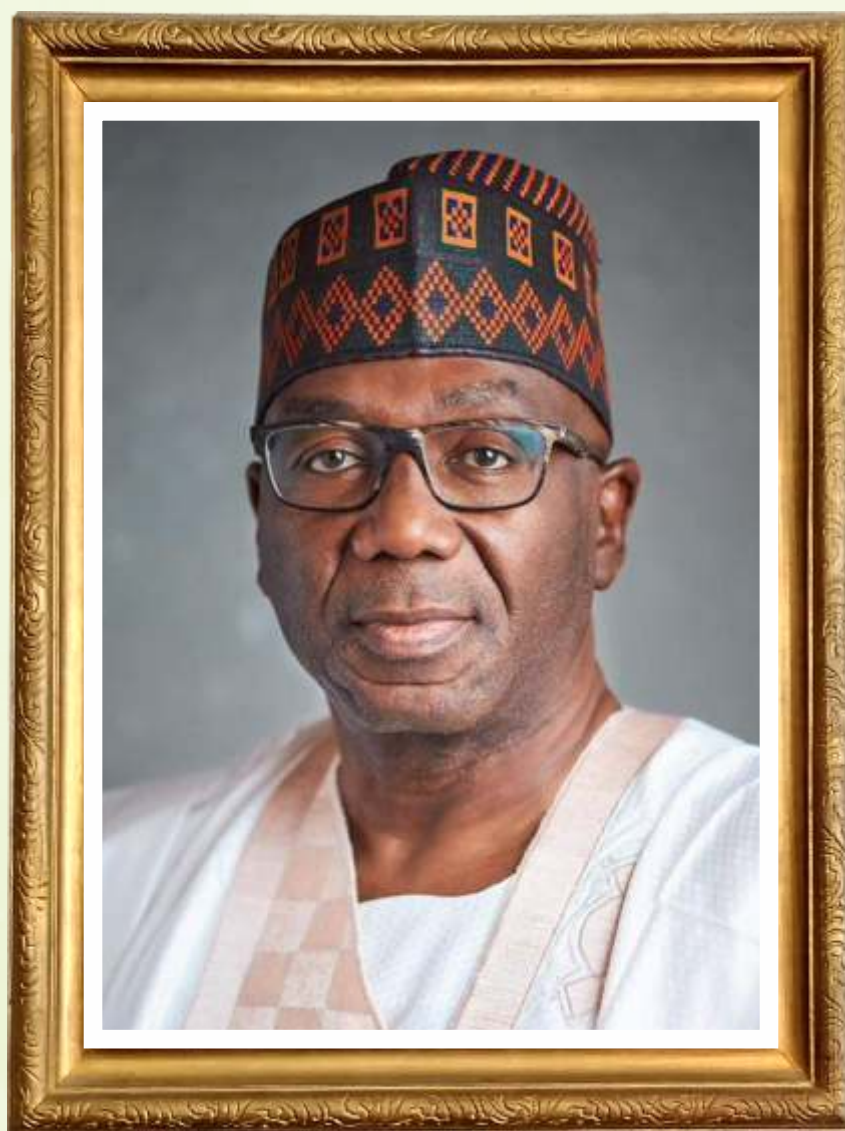

## HFN ADVOCACY ACTIVITIES

### ADVOCACY VISIT WITH THE FEDERAL MINISTRY OF FINANCE, BUDGET AND NATIONAL PLANNING



On 15th February 2023, the Healthcare Federation of Nigeria went with key stakeholders of the private healthcare sector (GE, Emzor, JNCI, Nirropharm, etc.) and Dr Ngozi Azodoh, Director of Health Planning, Research and Statistics, Federal Ministry of Health for a meeting in Abuja with the Federal Ministry of Finance, Budget and National Planning. At the meeting, HFN presented a position paper

on Fiscal Policy measures in Nigeria's Health Sector. The aim of the meeting was to request urgent action on critical fiscal policy measures to reposition Nigeria's healthcare sector in line with Nigeria's international convention obligations and inconsonance with current global innovation/best practices to optimize domestic healthcare delivery and save lives. This engagement with the FMFBNP is still ongoing

### HFN POSITION PAPER ON NSOANP



The HFN President, Dr. Pamela Ajayi, presented the HFN Position Paper on the National Surgical, Obstetrics, Anaesthesia, and Nursing Plan (NSOANP) to the Director of Hospital Services, Federal Ministry of Health, Dr. Jimoh Olawale Salaudeen. The document was compiled by a committee of specialist HFN members, including those in the Diaspora, comprising experienced Surgeons, Obstetricians, Anaesthetists, and Nurses/Midwives.

The HFN Position Paper on the NSOANP presents a holistic approach, encompassing education, workforce development, technological innovation, and systemic reforms, aiming to propel the Surgical, Obstetrics, Anaesthesia, and Nursing profession forward.

This presentation and participation of HFN in the NSOANP Stakeholders forum mark a historic milestone, signifying the inaugural inclusion of the private sector in this crucial policy discourse.

### COURTESY CALL TO AFCFTA



Following up on advocacy for health services to be made a priority sector in the Nigeria AfCFTA implementation strategy. On 1st June 2023, the HFN team paid a follow-up visit to the recently appointed Secretary Nation Action Committee on African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) in person of Mr. Olusegun Awolowo. Mr Awolowo invited HFN to be a key stakeholder for healthcare in the GTI (Guided Trade Initiative) aimed at

facilitating trade for exporters by creating a clear trade path and enhancing economic cooperation.



### WHO-STAKEHOLDERS WORKSHOP



HFN actively participated in the Joint World Health Organization (WHO) Stakeholders Workshop to evaluate the 3rd WHO-Nigeria Country Operation Strategy (2018-2022) and develop the 4th WHONigeria Country Cooperation Strategy. HFN President, Dr. Pamela Ajayi, emphasized the importance of activating the private sector, in nationwide strategies to harness collective strengths and resources for impactful outcomes.

### HEALTHCARE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE 2023



The HFN in partnership with Medic West Africa successfully hosted the highly anticipated Healthcare Leadership Conference 2023, a pivotal event that convened top dignitaries, healthcare experts, and thought leaders to chart a transformative path for healthcare in West Africa. The event brought together Commissioners of health from Lagos, Ogun, Osun, Imo, Ondo and Edo states.

This year's conference was graced by the presence of the Special Adviser to the Nigerian President on Health, Dr. Salma Anas, who highlighted the pressing need for increased public private partnerships within the healthcare sector.



## INTERNATIONAL CANCER WEEK IN NIGERIA



HFN President, Dr. Pamela Ajayi, at the International Cancer Week, Nigeria held in Abuja, spoke passionately on the critical importance of public-private integration.
